THE TURBO STORY

Dear collectors,

The **27th edition of the Autobrocante Festival** will be held on **5-6 October 2019** in the Manoir de l'Automobile et des Vieux Métiers in **Lohéac** (near Rennes).

The FCRA (*Fédération Française des clubs Renault et Alpine*) will be organising, with support from Renault Classic, a huge gathering of **turbocharged petrol engine cars** to celebrate the **40th anniversary of Renault's first Formula 1 win at the 1979 French Grand Prix**, the first time a turbo-powered car had prevailed in the motorsport's top flight category.

The weekend will provide visitors with the chance to discover the key, pioneering role played by Renault in the introduction and operation of turbo engines in Formula 1, and the transfer of its racing-derived technology into its production models.

Public access:

Saturday 5 and Sunday 6 October: open from 9am to 7pm.

Many events and activities will be held:

- Welcome coffee (Saturday and Sunday) and a cocktail (Saturday evening) in a new format in order to enjoy a special moment with the drivers, the Renault Classic teams and the registered participants.
- Track sessions each day (number and duration depending on the number of registered participants)
- Entry to the Autobrocante stands (second-hand sales of classic spare parts) for both days
- Entry to the museum for both days
- Parades of registered cars (one on each day)
- Display of turbo models from the Renault Classic collection
- Appearances by well-known drivers
- Renault Classic demonstrations
- Private autograph-signing sessions for registered participants (in addition to the sessions open to the public)
- Goodies

Payment of entry fees:

The full amount paid in Euros only, payable to the FCRA on registering entry of the vehicle. The sum will be debited from mid-September.

Accommodation: the organisation will not be providing accommodation.

Trailers: free parking is available.

Payment and general conditions

1 – Breakdown recovery vehicles, tractors and trailers

A dedicated car park for trailers will be made available to participants next to the site. Each participant should make provisions to ensure that their vehicle can be transferred independently from this car park to the exhibition area for these vehicles. No exceptions will be allowed.

2 – Compliance

Each participant agrees to ensure his/her registered vehicle is compliant with the applicable legislation and is solely responsible in case of non-compliance with said legislation. He/she agrees to strictly adhere to the regulations as well as all the terms of the contract.

3 – Image rights

Each participant agrees to be photographed, filmed by the organizer, the organizing agency or any other company or individual authorized accordingly by the organizer throughout the day as part of the promotion. He/she also agrees to allow his/her image and voice to be used by the organiser or by any other persons duly authorised by the organiser, on all media. He/she agrees that neither he/she nor any other person can claim any manner of remuneration in consideration for this authorization.

4 – Damage

Each participant shall be exclusively liable for any damage caused to the infrastructure. He/she acknowledges that he/she has familiarized him/herself with the participation conditions and shall strictly comply with them.

The applicant irrevocably waives on his/her own behalf and on that of his/her heirs and successors and any other physical or legal entities any recourse whatsoever against the organiser, its insurers or partners in respect of any material or physical damage that he/she or his/her passengers could cause to or suffer from third parties during this operation.

5 – Conditions for participation in the "Track sessions"

The registered vehicle must comply with the legislation in force at the date of the event.

The registered vehicle and its equipment must be in good working order.

The owner must be in possession of all compulsory administrative documents for the registered vehicle (registration documents, insurance, etc.) The insurance policy must cover this type of activity.

All participants acknowledge their registration in their own name in full knowledge of the risks related to driving on a circuit. He/she acknowledges that he/she has familiarized him/herself with the participation conditions and shall strictly comply with them.

Helmets must be worn. A maximum of two people in the car at all times (the passenger must be aged 18 or over).

Information concerning the protection of personal data

Respect for the protection of personal data constitutes an ethical value of Groupe RENAULT, in accordance with its Group Policy for the protection of personal data. <https://group.renault.com/nos-engagements/le-groupe-renault-et-vos-donnees-personnelles>

Renault takes all the necessary precautions to ensure that your personal data are processed securely and in accordance with the regulations.

Below you will find detailed information on the processing of your personal data in connection as part of registration for an event run by the FCRA.

Who are the controllers of your personal data?

Your personal data is processed by Renault SAS.

What are your personal data used for?

We gather your personal data when you fill in a registration form for an event, you contact us by email, post or telephone, or by any other means.

We use your personal data for:

- Forum/Community activities
- Events management
- Satisfaction surveys

Purposes	Legal basis
Managing your claim	This processing is based on our legitimate interest (prevention of legal actions)
Asking you to take part in satisfaction surveys about our events and operation of the community.	This processing is based on our legitimate interest (improving our services)
Responding to your requests for rights in relation to your personal data (see the section on “your rights”)	This processing is based on our legal obligations and involves in particular the verification of your identity
Managing registrations for events organised or run by the FCRA	This processing is justified by performance of the contract that you agreed to as part of registration.

In general, we are committed to collecting only the personal data that is necessary for each of the purposes for which we process your data.

As such, the mandatory nature of the answers is indicated in the collection forms. They are justified either by their necessity for the contract or the answer to your request, or by legal or regulatory obligation. If you do not wish to provide the required data, we will not be able to process your request. The other information is intended to know you better in the context of FCRA activities.

How long is your data kept?

In accordance with the regulations, we undertake to keep your personal data only for the duration necessary for the accomplishment of the purposes.

In order to calculate these retention periods, we rely in particular on the following criteria:

- The duration of your contract, if you have signed a contract with RENAULT
- The time required to process your request or claim
- Our legal and regulatory obligations

The data collected as part of organisation of the AUTOBROCANTE event in LOHEAC (35) will be kept until 31 December 2019.

We are required to keep, in archive, some of your personal data to be able to respond to any legal action, and for the duration required by the applicable legislation.

Who has access to your data?

We may share your personal data when we work with other entities of Groupe Renault such as Renault SAS as well as with partners and service providers, to process all or part of your personal data, insofar as this is necessary for the fulfilment of the tasks entrusted to them (for example, conducting a survey).

Wherever possible, your data is hosted on servers located in the European Economic Area (EEA). However, since some of our service providers are located in countries outside the EEA, your personal data is processed in these countries. Some of these countries may have different regulations concerning personal data than that of the European Union. In such a case, we pay particular attention to ensuring that this transfer is made in accordance with the applicable regulations and put in place safeguards ensuring a level of protection of your privacy and your fundamental rights equivalent to that offered by the European Union (specifically through the use of the European Commission's Standard Contractual Clauses). On simple request sent to the address mentioned in the section "What are your rights", we can provide you with more information on these transfers (particularly the standard contractual clauses of the European Commission).

Finally, we may disclose your personal data to third parties in order to comply with any legal obligation or administrative or judicial decision.

Your rights

You benefit from several rights concerning the processing of your personal data:

- A right of **access** to your personal data, that is to say the right to receive a copy.
- A right to **rectification**, if your data proved to be erroneous or out of date, which will enable us to comply with our obligation to have current data concerning you.
- A right to **erasure** (or right to be forgotten) of your personal data, which may be limited in relation to our contractual or legal obligations.
- A right to the **portability** of your data, that is to say the right to receive the personal data that you have provided to us, in a commonly-used, structured computer format and to transmit it to any other controller.
- A right of **opposition**, subject to justifying reasons relating to your particular situation, and the right to request the **limitation** of the processing of your personal data, in certain cases provided for by the regulations.
- A right of **opposition to all sales prospecting** (including profiling when it is used), which can be exercised via the unsubscribe link present in each prospecting email.
- A right to **withdraw your consent** at any time, for the purposes for which we have collected your consent.

You also have the option of defining general or specific instructions for certain processing tasks, for the storage, erasure and communication of your Personal Data in the event of your death. You can change or delete these instructions at any time. You can inform us of these special instructions by writing to the address stated above.

To exercise any of your rights, you can contact us, justifying your identity, by email at dpo@renault.com or by mail sent to the address Renault SAS, Legal Department - Data Protection Officer, 13/15 quai le Gallo, 92100 Boulogne-Billancourt.

Finally, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the French Data Protection Authority, the CNIL, about the processing of your personal data. We encourage you to contact us before any complaint, so that we can try to solve your problem together.

We may occasionally modify this information. Where necessary or required, we will notify you and/or seek your consent.
